

# THE USAGE OF SENTENCE-FINAL PARTICLES IN *ACTION COMICS KUREYON SHINCHAN 1*

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## Abstract

This paper aims to find out the usage of Japanese sentence-final particles. The source data is a comic book entitled *action comics kureyon shinchan 1*. Japanese particles found in the data are analyzed descriptively by categorizing them based on the gender and age of the speakers. Several sentence-final particles can be found in the data, such as *wa*, *yo*, *ne*, *no*, *wa yo*. Some of those sentence-final particles are gender and age-restricted; they can only be used by specific genders and ages.

**Keywords** – *sentence-final particles, Japanese comics, kureyon shinchan*

## Introduction

The Japanese language has many sentence-final particles used in sentences both in oral and written expression. The study of this theme, Japanese sentence-final particles, has drawn many intentions from scholars. For example, in the study of sentence-final particle *yo* (Davis, 2011), in the study of sentence-final particle *yo* and *ne* (Katagiri, 2007), in the study of sentence-final particle *ne* (Cook, 2009), in the study of sentence-final particle *no*, *koto*, and *to/tte* (Okamoto, 1996), and so on. The most studied Japanese sentence-final particles are *yo* and *ne*. The basic Japanese lesson textbook, *Minna no Nihongo*, introduces these two sentence-final particles. However, there are many other sentence-final particles in Japanese. This paper aims to identify sentence-final particles used in daily conversation using a comic book as its data source.

## Methods




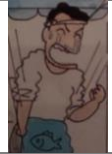







This paper aims to identify the usage of sentence-final particles used in a popular Japanese comic entitled *action comics kureyon shinchan 1*. However, due to the limitation of time and space, the data analyzed was until the episode of *ora to kaa-chan wa otomodachi na no yo hen (sono 12)*, i.e., page 47 of the book.

First, all the sentence-final particles that appeared in the comic were recorded. The users of those sentence-final particles were also recorded to identify whether those sentence-final particles were gender-specific or not. And also whether those sentence-final particles are related to the age of the speakers.

## Finding and Discussion

Eleven characters appear in the comic that uses sentence-final particles. The characteristics of the characters are as follows (Wikipedia, 2023).

There are twelve sentence-final particles found in the data. Those particles are *wa*, *yo*, *ne*, *no*, *wa yo*, *no yo*, *wa ne*, *me*, *na*, *ya*, *zo*, and *yo na*. The usage of the sentence-final particles is as follows.

### 3.1 Sentence-Final Particle *wa*

The data found for sentence-final particle *wa* can be summarized in Table 2.

In Tabel 12, the characters that used this particle *zo* are mostly male. The female character, the elevator girl, who is a staff in a department store whose job is to operate the elevator for the customer, is only using the particle *zo* to express her unhappiness and anger toward Shinnosuke Nohara, the main character in this comic, who is acting weird and tempting her. Also, she said this sentence only in her mind, not out loud.

The data found for sentence-final particle *yo na* can be summarized in Table 13.

The context in the data shown in Table 13 was a sentence from a male company employee when he was asked to find and secure a place to enjoy seeing Sakura flowers in the park. This male employee is talking to himself.

### Conclusion

From the findings presented in the previous chapter, there are several gender-specific sentence-final particles, i.e., particle *wa*, *wa yo*, *no yo*, *wa ne*, and *ne*, which are used only by females. Particle *ne*, *no*, even though both genders can use them, the findings show that females mostly use these particles. On the other hand, particles *yo*, *na*, and *zo* can be used by both genders, and the findings show that males mostly use these particles. The particle used only by males in the data is *yo na*. the particle *both genders can use ya* in the same proportion. However, the male character using the particle *ya* is the main character, Shinnosuke Nohara, who is still a 5-year-old boy who likes to imitate her mother and father's way of saying things.

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
