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Abstrak: Penelitian kualitatif ini berfokus pada analisis aspek psikologis yang terdapat pada tokoh utama khususnya Wanda Maximoff atau yang juga dikenal sebagai Scarlet Witch. Data tersebut diperoleh dari film berjudul Doctor Strange: Multiverse of Madness. Dalam mengumpulkan data penelitian, penelitian ini juga menggunakan metode observasi melalui beberapa langkah yaitu: mengunduh dan menonton film Doctor Strange dua kali untuk mendapatkan pemahaman yang komprehensif tentang cerita, membaca naskah film sambil mengamati dialog dan aksi tokoh utama dalam film, menyoroti dan mencatat adegan dan peristiwa terkait aspek psikologis motivasi manusia. Penelitian ini juga menerapkan teori Benhardt (1953) mengenai klasifikasi aspek psikologis dalam menganalisis masalah penelitian. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan terdapat 8 data terkait aspek psikologis motivasi manusia yang dialami oleh tokoh utama.

**Abstract:** This qualitative research focuses on the analysis of psychological aspects that are found in the main character especially Wanda Maximoff or also known as Scarlet Witch. The data were obtained from a movie entitled Doctor Strange: Multiverse of Madness. In collecting the research data, this research also used observation method through several steps namely: downloading and watching Doctor Strange movie twice to get the comprehensive understanding about the story, reading the movie's script while observing the main character's dialogue and action in the movie, highlighting and taking a note the related scenes and events of the psychological aspect of human motivation. This study also applies Benhardt's theory (1953) regarding to the classification of psychological aspects in analyzing the research problem. The results show there are 8 data related to the psychological aspects of human motivation experienced by the main character.

### Introduction

Literature is written texts that are made through the use of language including some features including creative metaphor, elegant syntax, aesthetic rhyme, and alliteration (Meyer, 1997:4). According to Warren and Wellek (1973:3), literature can be illustrated as human expression and creation that are constructed into written art by exploring their thoughts, feelings, and perceptions based on the reflection of human's life. It has some significant purposes as the public consumption such as entertainment, education, and also motivation. Moreover,



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literature can be produced into several types such as poetry, novel, short story, and drama. There are some genres that are usually adapted in literary works including romance, adventure, mystery, horror, etc. On the other hand, there are some genres such as action, comedy, and war that can be better if they are performed visually.

Movie is the most popular literary work that represents several conflicts around the world. According to Hornby (2006), movie is sequences of a story that are performed through visual images and audio effects. In providing a storytelling, movie can also be divided into two categories they are fiction and non-fiction. Furthermore, there are two elements that build a movie as a part of literary work namely intrinsic and extrinsic elements. In literature, extrinsic elements are author's life, historical, cultural, and social backgrounds. On the other hand, intrinsic elements can be divided into theme, character, characterization, setting, plot, point of view, style and tone. Character is the most important element that is very interesting to be analyzed in this study. Because, it reflects the human characterization in the real life.

According to Kennedy (1983:45), characters are imaginative figures that can describe the writer's perspective and also creativity as the reflection of human characteristics and experiences. On the other hand, Abram (1981:20) in Nurgiyantoro (1990) explains that character is an individual or group that are performed in the literary work with some particular moralities and principles during the story. There are two aspects that can express the characters' point of view into the conflicts; speech and action. Tarigan (1985) classifies the types of character into frequency engagement and function. There are three types of character based on its frequency of engagement, they are; main character, secondary character, and supporting character. However, there are protagonist and antagonist based on its function. Each character expresses their personalities and behaviors that can be followed by the audience as the psychological aspect of character in the movie.

Psychological aspect concerns to the character's personality and behavior that are experienced by some particular individuals in their life during the movie. Psychology influences the person's point of view including their interests, actions, and motives. Each character shows their interests and actions differently based on their motives, for instance, friendly, arrogant, hardworking, and selfish. According



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to Benhardt (1953), every human behaviors and actions are based on the human motivation. He also classifies there are five concepts of human motivation as a fundamental of someone for doing something, they are: appetites, wants, emotions, feelings and attitudes, and social motives.

Aryanti (2022) states that the psychological aspect is very strong to support the reasons of the main character's actions in Cruella movie. She concludes that the aspect of wants dominates the main character's motivation when she is doing something because her conflicts and incidents are very emotional as she wants everything to relieve her anger and fulfill her goal. This previous research is very useful to support this study because it shows how the human motivation can be influenced by the conflicts and incidents from their environment as the psychological aspect that can affect their behaviors and actions. While, Intan, et. al. (2016) states that the psychological aspect that can construct human motivation as a fundamental of Maleficent's behaviors and actions in Maleficent movie. She portrays Maleficent as the most suffering character in this movie because she is betrayed by human in the past. Her motivation controls herself to do everything that she wants to release her disappointment and hatred. This previous research analyzes the human motivation by applying Benhardt's theory (1945) to support the research analysis. Furthermore, Pramurti (2022) states that the psychological aspect also influences the main characters' behaviors and actions in Bird of Prey movie. She presents that the psychological aspect and the main characters show a good engagement to develop the story.

There are some similarities and differences that are found between this research and previous studies. First, this research is very similar in analyzing the psychological aspect of the main character in the movie by using Benhardt's theory (1953). Second, this research uses Doctor Strange: Multiverse of Madness movie as the main data source which is similar to the previous studies. On the other hand, the difference is also found in the rest of research problems. This research is only focused on the psychological aspect while the previous studies analyze plot and conflict as their second research problem. Based on the background above, this study focuses on the analysis of psychological aspect through the main female character especially Wanda Maximoff or also well-known as Scarlet Witch through



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the movie that is produced by Marvel Studios entitled "Doctor Strange: Multiverse of Madness" (2022).

### Methodology

This research applied descriptive qualitative method to analyze the research problem based on the theory that proposed in this study. In collecting the research data, this research also used observation method through several steps namely: downloading and watching Doctor Strange movie twice to get the comprehensive understanding about the story, reading the movie's script while observing the main character's dialogue and action in the movie, and highlighting and taking a note the related scenes and events of the psychological aspect of human motivation. Furthermore, each collected data were analyzed based on Benhardt's theory (1953) as the fundamental theory of the psychological aspect in this study.

In this study, the data were taken from a movie entitled Doctor Strange: Multiverse of Madness. This movie released on May 2022 in the United States. This movie was about the superhero's story when Doctor Strange tried to stop Wanda Maximoff or also known as Scarlet Witch to open the book of Darkhold. Wanda is very ambitious to control the power of dark magic because she wanted to meet her children in another universe. Therefore, this phenomenon is very interesting to be analyzed because Wanda Maximoff has a strong motivation as it can be explained through Benhardt's theory (1953) related to the psychological aspect of the human motivation.

## **Result and Discussion**

According to Warren and Wellek (1962:81), psychology in literature can be described as the creative process of expressing the psychology's types and laws to the readers or audience including feelings, emotions, attitudes, motivations, and temperaments. Moreover, Benhardt (1953) explains that human motivation covers two problems, they are; to describe types of aspect based on the individual's activity and to consider which aspect is more dominant in a particular situation. As a result, he classifies human motivation into five elements such as appetites, wants, emotions, feelings and attitudes, and social motives. The finding of this research

shows that there are some psychological aspects of human motivation that found in Wanda Maximoff as the main female villain in this study as explained below.

Based on the table above, there are 8 data that are found in the study which cover five aspects of human motivation they are; 1 (12,5%) data of Appetites, 1 (12,5%) data of Wants, 3 (37,5%) data of Emotions, 1 (12,5%) data of Feelings and Attitudes, and 2 (25%) data of Social Motives. The Aspect of Emotions dominates Wanda Maximoff's actions as the main character in Doctor Strange: Multiverse of Madness movie. Because, she is suffering in the complicated situation where she is lonely, hopeless, and depressed with her anger, disappointment, and hatred at the same time.

## 1. Appetites

According to Benhardt (1953), appetites are something that related to human needs or desires which must be satisfied. If humans cannot get their appetites, they will survive to fulfill these needs. Appetites can be considered repeated or frequentative actions such as hunger, thirst, sex, sleep, love, pain avoidance, etc. These activities are constructed as their habits or daily routines as their strategy to survive in the world. As a human being, Wanda Maximoff experienced these basic needs even though she also has the power of Scarlet Witch at the same time. There are an example of appetites as psychological aspect of human motivation that occur through the scenes in the movie as explained below.

This data shows that Wanda is dreaming about Billy and Tommy through her sleep. She is in the condition of dream walking, where she is happy since it can be seen from her big smile because Wanda can meet her children even though it is only in her dream. Based on the data above, the main character is fulfilling one of her appetites which is taking a rest. Sleeping is one of the basic needs of human being. They will take a rest if they feel tired after working in whole day. Moreover, Wanda Maximoff has a purpose for her sleep, she also needs to fulfill her satisfaction to meet with her children from another universe although it is only on her dream. This scene is categorized as psychological aspect of human motivation as the main character's appetite since Wanda Maximoff follows her desire to take a rest as her own satisfaction.

### Conclusion

Based on the results and discussion above, it can be concluded that psychological aspect of human motivation influences the individual to take an action as the way of expressing their motives. Wanda Maximoff or also known as Scarlet Witch is the main female villain in the movie entitled Doctor Strange: Multiverse of Madness, as an individual who survives in her complicated situation. She shows some human motivation as a way of Wanda Maximoff to express her action through the movie. According to Benhardt (1953), every human behaviors and actions are based on the human motivation. He also classifies there are five concepts of human motivation as a fundamental of someone for doing something, they are: appetites, wants, emotions, feelings and attitudes, and social motives. There are 8 data which cover five aspects of human motivation they are; 1 (12,5%) data of Appetites, 1 (12,5%) data of Wants, 3 (37,5%) data of Emotions, 1 (12,5%) data of Feelings and Attitudes, and 2 (25%) data of Social Motives. The Aspect of Emotions dominates Wanda Maximoff's actions as the main character in Doctor Strange: Multiverse of Madness movie.
